



# VERSATILITY PROGRAM

*Anytime a fee is required, please use a check payable to AWCA*

## TITLE REQUIREMENTS

Purpose – To promote the versatile nature of the Collie. Originally bred as a working stock dog, the Collie developed a wide range of talents. The Versatility Program recognizes AWCA Collies that have proven their competence as versatile working dogs.

**VERSATILITY COMPANION (VC)** – Title to be earned by gaining 5 points from a minimum of 3 categories.

**VERSATILITY COMPANION EXCELLENT (VCX)** – Title to be earned by gaining 10 points from a minimum of 5 categories; at least 2 points from 2 different categories must be earned from Intermediate level work (e.g. CDX, HA, OA, etc.).

**VERSATILITY CHAMPION (VCH)** – Title to be earned by gaining 15 points from 6 categories; at least 2 points from 2 different categories must be earned from Advanced level work (e.g. UD, HX, AX, etc.).

**GRAND VERSATILITY CHAMPION (GVCH)** – Must have earned a VCH plus any 3 of the following 4 titles: Stock Work, HX or higher; Obedience, UD or higher; Scent Work, TDX or higher, or 3 live, cadaver, narcotics, explosives, or agricultural finds, documented by authorities; Canine Sports—Agility, AX or AXJ or its equivalent or higher.

## I. STOCK WORK

**(A maximum of 6 points possible from this category; 2 points maximum from Novice level titles, 2 points maximum from Intermediate level titles, 2 points maximum from Advanced level titles)**

(If your organization wishes to hold a sanctioned AWCA Herding Instinct Test, send a Priority Mail stamp with your request for the AWCA Herding Instinct Program to the Stock Work Coordinator.)

- A. AWCA – HTD, HTDX, HTCH
- B. ASCA – STD, OTD, ATD, PATD, RD, RTD, WTCH
- C. AKC – HT, PT, HS, HI, HX, HC
- D. AHBA – HCT, JHD, HTD I, II, III, HRD I, II, III, HTAD I, II, III, HTCH
- E. Working Farm or Ranch Dog\*

## II. OBEDIENCE

**(A maximum of 6 points possible from this category; 2 points maximum from Novice level titles, 2 points maximum from Intermediate level titles, 2 points maximum from Advanced level titles)**

- A. Obedience – BN, CD, PCD, GN, CDX, PCDX, GO, VER, UD, PUTD, OM, OTCH or equivalent obedience title from any recognized registry.
- B. Rally – RN, RA, RE, RAE, RM, RACH or equivalent rally title from any recognized registry.

## III. SOUNDNESS

**(A maximum of 4 points possible from this category with 1 point only from any one of the medical tests listed. Only Novice level points available in this category)**

- A. AWCA HC or other herding instinct certification (certificate required) – 1 point only from an instinct level test
- B. CGC, CGCA, CGCU, or CGN – 1 point only from a general manners test
- C. FDC
- D. TT or TC or ATTS – 1 point (only 1 point from a temperament test)
- E. Medical tests: CEA normal; MDR1 normal/normal; OFA hips or PennHips excellent – 1 point only from a medical test

## IV. SCENT WORK

**(A maximum of 6 points possible from this category; 2 points maximum from Novice level titles, 2 points maximum from Intermediate level titles, 2 points maximum from Advanced level titles)**

- A. Tracking – 1 point for each title at all levels from AKC, CKC, ASCA, or other recognized registry (e.g. TD, TDX, VST, CT)
- B. Nose Work titles from recognized organizations
- C. Barn Hunt titles from recognized organizations; 1 Novice point, 1 Intermediate point only
- D. Narcotics, Bomb, Agriculture Products Detection\*
- E. Search and Rescue or Professional Tracking Dog\*
- F. Water Rescue\*

## V. DRAFT WORK

**(A maximum of 6 points possible from this category; 2 points maximum from Novice level titles, 2 points maximum from Intermediate level titles, 2 points maximum from Advanced level titles)**

- A. Sledding – Sled Team Member (STM), Sled Lead Dog (SLD); a copy of the AWCA Sledding Program may be obtained by sending \$2.00 (check made payable to AWCA) and business-size SASE to the Draft Work Coordinator.
- B. Ski-Journing\*
- C. Carting (CRT, CRTX); a copy of the AWCA Carting Program may be obtained by sending \$5.00 (check made payable to AWCA) to the Draft Work Coordinator.
- D. Backpacking – Backpack Dog (BPD, BPD, BPW, BPGW); a copy of the AWCA Backpacking Program may be obtained by sending \$1.00 (check made payable to AWCA) and business-size SASE to the Draft Work Coordinator.

\*These activities should be verified in writing on 3 separate occasions by 3 separate officials (dog club officer, licensed judge, park ranger, etc.) unrelated to the owner of the dog.

## VI. ASSISTANCE WORK

**(1 point for each type of work or service or title earned. Guide, Hearing, & Service Dogs are considered Advanced level work)**

- A. Guide Dog\*\*
- B. Hearing Dog\*\*
- C. Service Dog\*\*
- D. Social Dog Program (SOC I, SOC II, SOC III); Therapy Dog Program (THR I, THR II, THR III); a copy of the AWCA Social Dog Program or the AWCA Therapy Dog Program may each be obtained by sending \$1, check made payable to AWCA, and a business-size SASE to the Social/Therapy Program Coordinator.
- E. Heroic Feats (Documented)

\*\*Certification from the training center or private trainer, and letters from veterinarians, librarians, postal workers, etc., required to document the dog's work plus 1 full year of documentation with photographs or videos or DVDs of the dog working in various public access situations, written statements by witnesses such as: doorkeepers, postal workers, veterinarians, etc., written description and photos/videos/DVDs of the dog's specific skills utilized by the human partner.

## VII. CANINE SPORTS

**(A maximum of 6 points possible from this category; 2 points maximum from Novice level titles, 2 points maximum from Intermediate level titles, 2 points maximum from Advanced level titles)**

- A. Agility – Agility titles from recognized organizations
- B. Flyball – Flyball titles from recognized organizations
- C. Scent Hurdle – Scent hurdle titles from recognized organizations
- D. Frisbee – Frisbee titles from recognized organizations
- E. Lure Coursing – Titles from AKC Coursing Ability program—1 point only
- F. Trick Dog—Titles from recognized organizations.—maximum of 2 points

## VIII. CONFORMATION

**(1 point for each CH from an approved registry/organization; e.g. AKC, CKC, FCI)**

- A. Conformation Championship (CH)
- B. Conformation Certificate (CC) – To obtain the title CC (which is placed after the dog's name) the dog must be examined by 5 judges (2 group, 1 a breeder of a champion Collie) and the CC forms filled out (exception: a pointed dog, neutered, elderly, infirm, or otherwise ineligible for the breed ring with show records of wins under 5 judges accepted). A copy of the AWCA Conformation Certification Program may be obtained by sending \$2.00, check made payable to AWCA, and a business-size SASE to the Conformation Coordinator. **NOTE:** To earn multiple Versatility points in this category, titles must be earned in different countries (Example, AKC CH or AWCA CC – 1 point; CKC CH – 1 point; etc.).

## IX. PUBLIC RELATIONS

**(A maximum of 2 points possible from this category: 1 point from 6 different dates of participation in the same activity; or 1 combination point from 6 different dates of participation in mixed activities – any combination of them. Only Novice level points available in this category)**

- A. Education\*\*\* – Active participation in demonstrations, seminars, clinics, Scottish Festivals.
- B. Entertainment\*\*\* – Modeling (with dog under command for professional assignment, i.e., published print ads (no show photos), TV commercials, runway); acting; drill teams; square dancing; freestyle dance (rehearsed performance before an audience); parades.
- D. Precision Work (PWI). For program requirements, send \$1.00, check made payable to AWCA, and SASE, to the Public Relations Coordinator.
- C. Open

\*\*\*AWCA Public Relations Verification form required plus one additional piece of documentation – may include 1 or more of the following: copy of photo taken at an event (required for modeling); copy of dated flyer of an event; news clipping or any writeup of an event in a publication; copy of letterhead letter from an organization involved in event. Send SASE to coordinator for verification form.

To apply for points, photocopies of title certifications and/or verifications should be submitted to the appropriate program coordinator along with a large SASE. When you have sufficient points in the required number of categories, submit photocopies of your point slips along with your completed Versatility Title Request form to the Versatility Director with a \$5.00 check payable to AWCA for each title (VC, VCX, VCH, GVCH).
